General City Tickets to Attractions- Philadelphia City Pass

Visit SIX Philadelphia Attractions anytime during your stay for 1 LOW Price. CityPass is simple. Buy your CityPass either on-line or at any of the six attractions. You will have nine days to visit each attraction for a single visit. Your CityPass booklet is valid for nine days beginning the first day you use it. You avoid standing in line. Simple present your CityPass booklet on your way into each attraction for your admission. Ticket includes a pass on the Trolley Works. Locations include:

- a. National Constitution Center
- b. The Franklin Institute
- c. Adventure Aquarium
- d. Philadelphia Zoo
- e. Academy of Natural Sciences
- f. Eastern State Penitentiary

Guests can purchase tickets at 5th and Market St. (7 blocks directly east of hotel located at 12th and Market Street). Tours depart every 30 minutes from 9:30 am-4:30 pm.

Philly Trolley or Double Decker Bus Tour

Guests can buy a 24 hour pass or a 48 hour pass. With the purchase of a ticket they can jump on and off the trolley or bus at their convenience. The trolley will continue to visit the following 20 sites daily.

Independence Tour

This guided walking tour will retrace the footsteps of Benjamin Franklin and his fellow patriots during the founding of our nation. Highlights include Independence Hall where the Declaration of Independence was signed, The Liberty Bell and Carpenter's Hall, where the Continental Congress met to discuss their grievances with England. Along the way you will visit Christ Church, where Ben Franklin and our founding fathers worshipped, The Betsy Ross House where the first flag was made and the Christ Church burial ground; the final resting place of Ben Franklin and many historic leaders.

Learn about the National Constitution Center, the historic area's newest attraction that explores the United States Constitution, a worldwide symbol of freedom and justice. Join us as at the Sightseeing Kiosk located inside The Independence Visitor's Center to walk back in time to colonial Philadelphia and the birthplace of a nation. (Approximate length: 75 minutes)
